THE NURSES WILL LEARN WHERE TO SEEK PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT, HOW TO TAKE PARENTS' CONSENT ABOUT PARTICIPATION IN RESEARCH OR MEDICAL INTERVENTIONS AND WHICH ARE THEIR CERTAIN ROLES IN CASE OF EMERGENCY.
